



Faculty Position in Family and Community Services
Department of Child Development and Family Relations
East Carolina University

The Department of Child Development and Family Relations at East Carolina University (ECU) invites applications for a 9-month tenure-track faculty position in the Family and Community Service program available at the Assistant professor level starting August 16, 2010. Review of applications will begin October 1 and continue until filled.

Responsibilities: Teach undergraduate and graduate courses; advise students; supervise graduate work; develop and maintain an active research program; secure external funding, and provide service to the profession, community, and university.

Qualifications: Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in family studies, family life education, or a closely related field of study. Experience with intern supervision and other community-based or agency experience preferred. Experience in teaching or conducting program evaluation is desirable. Candidates should hold or be eligible for certification in family life education (CFLE). Successful candidates must be committed to working with diverse student and community populations.

The Department of Child Development and Family Relations is one of six departments in the College of Human Ecology. It has approximately 500 full-time students and 150 licensure only students enrolled in the undergraduate programs of family and community services, birth-kindergarten teacher education, family and consumer sciences education, and child life. An additional 90 students are enrolled in the Master's programs of child development and family relations, birth-kindergarten teacher education, family and consumer sciences education, marriage and family therapy, and the Ph.D. in medical family therapy.
