

Business Administration Minor

No matter what career path you choose, a business administration minor will broaden your horizon – giving you an edge in the job hunt while teaching you skills necessary to succeed both professionally and personally. From the fine arts to health care, a business administration minor can compliment any major or degree!

There are no special admission requirements; simply notify your academic advisor that you wish to earn a business minor. The minor will be verified and awarded the semester a student graduates after grades have been finalized. The business minor is intended to complement your major, and the minor is recognized when that degree is completed.

It is recommended that the courses required for the business administration minor be taken in the order listed.

The minor requires **24 s.h.** (semester hours) of credit as follows:
