



Pirate Tutoring Center Peer Tutors Needed

The Pirate Tutoring Center offers peer tutoring sessions on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, 6:30pm to 9pm in Joyner Library. Tutors will be required to work a 6:15pm to 9pm shift at least two times per month.

Peer Tutor Job Description

Peer Tutors will work in their most qualified subject area(s) (a student must have earned an A or a B to be qualified to tutor in the subject). Tutors will primarily work one-on-one with students to help with the comprehension of course material and study skills development. Some small group sessions may be held based on student need.

Benefits of the Tutoring Experience

There are many benefits in participating in the Pirate Tutoring Program. By volunteering to be a peer tutor, you will be providing a much needed service to peers, gain valuable experience to assist you in your personal development, and receive valuable training to improve your own success as a student.

Minimum Qualifications

Must be an ECU student:

- ✓ Have Minimum GPA of a 3.00.
- ✓ Successfully completed a minimum of 30 semester hours at ECU.(preferred)
- ✓ Must be a full time student enrolled in at least 12 semester hours of coursework.
- ✓ Must have earned at least an A or B in the courses identified for tutoring and have taken those courses at East Carolina University.
- ✓ Must have excellent communication skills and be able to work with students from diverse backgrounds with varied skill levels. Previous tutoring experience is valued but not required. Training will be provided.
