

ACADEMIC PROBATION

Students are placed on academic probation when they have not met the GPA required for their classification (*See Academic Eligibility*). Students on academic probation **must** raise their cumulative GPA to the minimum requirement for their retention standard to avoid suspension. If the student fails to do so, he/she will be suspended.

Strategies to receive an automatic appeal after a suspension

- Earn a semester GPA of 2.5 on 12 hours
- Be within 5 QP of minimum GPA requirement
- Attend summer school at ECU and earn 2.5 on 12 hours
- Write a letter of appeal (*See Academic Suspension and Appeal*)
