

CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

New freshman and transfer students can declare Construction Management upon admission to ECU. A new student is defined as having no ECU credits posted on Banner yet. This means that a student with no ECU credit posted can switch to construction management immediately. Once a student has established an ECU GPA, they would follow the ECU change of major eligibility requirements listed below.

Students transferring in with an AAS in Construction or related major must meet with the department chair, Dr. Doug Kruger, before attending ECU to choose 9 credits of guided CMGT courses. These students are required to have MATH 1065 and PHYS 1250 and 1251 before transferring into the ECU Construction Management program.

Readmitted students can also declare Construction Management upon readmission to ECU as long as they have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher (summer can be used to bring up GPA to this level as it is not a regular semester).

ECU Students wanting to change to Construction Management. Change of majors are only accepted in the spring semester.

Requirements to declare Construction Management:

- 2.3 cumulative GPA
- ITEC 2000 or MIS 2223
- MATH 1065 or 1066
- PHYS 1250 and 1251

If students have all requirements met before spring semester, they may begin taking construction courses that semester. If the requirements will be complete at the end of the spring semester, they may sign up for summer (if available) or fall Construction courses during the registration period in spring. Requirements will be checked at the end of spring to be sure they have been met. If not met, all construction classes will be dropped for summer and fall.

General Rules to be aware of:

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required to stay in the program. Students are allowed one semester to bring their GPA up (summer can be used to bring up GPA to this level as it is not a regular semester). If students do not meet this requirement by the end of the second semester, they will be assigned to General College and will no longer be considered in the program. Advising for these students would be done through the Academic Advising and Support Center. In order to reenter the program, students would need to follow the requirements for ECU students to change major.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 to take any CMGT class, including CMGT 2200, which is open to all majors.

Note: A minimum of 7 semesters is required for the program. It is generally not possible to speed up the program and will become even harder to do so in the future.
