Graduation from the Honors Program Offers Opportunity for Excellence

- *University Honors*: 30 semester hours of Honors, including 6 hours devoted to a Senior Honors Research Project, with an overall 3.5 GPA and a 3.5 GPA in Honors courses (grades of "C" or below do not count).
- *Foundations Curriculum Honors Courses*: 24 semester hours of Honors courses with a minimum of a 3.3 GPA overall and a 3.3 GPA in Honors courses (grades of "C" or below do not count).

Honors Course Listings

- *Honors Seminars* are indicated by the prefix HNRS. These seminars address "special" topics and change each semester. They also fulfill the "Writing Intensive" requirement.
- *Honors Sections of Regular Courses* are offered by a wide variety of academic departments. These courses are designated by sections 294-299.
- *Honors by Contract* is an agreement between the Director of the Honors Program, a professor, and the student to complete additional work in order to earn Honors credit.
