

MILITARY CREDIT

Students who have satisfactorily completed basic military training may receive credit for HLTH 1000 and one hour of exercise (EXSS) upon submitting a DD214, SMART or AARTS transcript to the Office of the Registrar. Students who have completed service schools while on active duty with the military may request an evaluation through the Office of the Registrar. Credit will be awarded upon the recommendation and review of the appropriate academic department.

Please note that East Carolina requires that $\frac{1}{2}$ of the courses in a major be completed at East Carolina, that $\frac{1}{2}$ of the hours for a degree (e.g., 60 hours of a degree requiring 120 hours) be completed at a senior (four-year) college or university, and that a minimum of 30 hours be completed at East Carolina. Credit awarded for military experience does not count toward credit from a senior institution.
