Dear Student:

Congratulations from the Office of the Registrar. Although you were on suspension for the upcoming semester, your academic performance over summer sessions allows you to enroll in classes in the fall 2006 semester.

We are ready and willing to help you in your educational progress at East Carolina University at any time. Please consider the following as you plan your fall semester:

- Be sure to contact your academic advisor to review your schedule or register for fall 2006 classes.
- Review and understand your academic standing with your academic advisor.

- Recognize that although you did not remain suspended at this time, your suspension status will advance if you do not meet the minimum GPA standard in the future.

For example, a student who was suspended 4A for one semester and becomes eligible to attend classes, but does not meet their required eligibility standard in the future, will then become advanced a suspension level -4B and suspended for two semesters.
