Note that the LATN and GRK courses can be reversed (i.e., 3 years of GRK and 2 years of LATN). It is strongly recommended that students intending to pursue graduate work in Classics use their electives for additional language courses. If possible (e.g. via A.P. or transfer credits), it is also recommended that such students begin both languages by freshman year.
