III. College of Fine Arts and Communication

School of Communication (Mary Tucker-McLaughlin)

- 1. Summary of Request
- 2. Banking of COMM 2210 and COMM 3322
- 3. Revision of Existing Courses: COMM 2120, COMM 3104

Dr. Tucker-McLaughlin gave an overview of why the proposed changes are being made. These changes will better reflect what is being taught in the course.

According to Dr. Tucker-McLaughlin, the proposed banked courses have not been taught in 6-7 years. Diane Coltraine suggested deleting the courses instead of banking them. The difference between banking versus deleting courses was discussed, and the committee recommended they be deleted instead of banked. Dr. Tucker-McLaughlin agreed. Deb Jordan made a motion to table the banking portion of this package. Stacy Weiss seconded the motion. The committee unanimously approved. Dr. Tucker-McLaughlin will arrange an electronic vote with the School of Communication faculty and administration to expedite an upload documentation of the faculty vote to this proposal. Karen Traynor will revise this form and it will be brought back to the committee for review.

Revision of COMM 2120: Edits to the course description were discussed and Stacy Weiss suggested changing the course description to read: Survey of theoretical, social, behavioral, and communicative

Revision of COMM 3104: Gail Ratcliff mentioned that this is a WI course and should reflect the components of writing in the grading section. Recommendations were made to discuss WAC course requirements with faculty to ensure WAC requirements are included.

Motion made by Stacy Weiss to accept the revisions of COMM 2120 and COMM 3104. Seconded by Gail Ratcliff. Unanimously approved.

IV. College of Fine Arts and Communication

School of Communication (Mary Tucker-McLaughlin)

Revision of Communication, BS includes the revision of transfer student admission information in the catalog and the addition of COMM 3190 to electives for the following concentrations:

- Interpersonal/Organizational Communication
- Media Studies
- Public Relations

Revision of Communication Studies Minor includes decreasing the overall hours of the minor from 24 s.h. to 18 s.h.

Diane Coltraine mentioned GPA note in the Public Relations concentration only needs to be included in one section. Diane will remove this from the concentration note field in the catalog copy.

The committee suggested the School of Communication faculty consider renaming the minor "Communication, Communication Studies Minor" since it is redundant. Dr. Tucker-McLaughlin stated there has been discussion for years regarding the redundancy, however the faculty have never agreed to change the minor title.

Motion made by Deb Jordan to approve the amended proposals. Cyndi Bellacero seconded the motion. Unanimously approved.

V. New Business (Jean-Luc Scemama)

UCC Goals for 2019-2020:

Consent Agenda for uncontroversial packages where faculty would not need to attend UCC meetings will be discussed at the next meeting. The consent agenda process has been instituted this academic year by the GCC.
