

Service-Learning Report to Faculty Senate December 3, 2013

The University Service-Learning Committee is bringing forward seven service-learning designation course proposal approvals made by the committee for the Fall semester 2013. One course included as a committee approval in the minutes, PSYC 3206: Developmental Psychology, was removed at the Department Chair's request. The first three courses (BUSI 220, HLTH 2500 and COAD 6406) were approved prior to the transition of the committee to the status of a Faculty Senate Committee and need to be formally approved for catalog designation and the last four courses are new proposals for the Fall 2013 semester. After committee deliberation and completion of suggested revisions, the committee approved these eight proposals and the committee respectfully requests that the Senate approve the courses as well.

The committee voted to approve the following course designations to be included in the catalog. The asterisk indicates that only some sections will be designated as SL (this is consistent with catalog procedures):

Formerly approved courses, brought forward for catalog designation purposes:

1. BUSI 2200: Leadership I: Team Building and Interpersonal Skills, SL* (Initially approved in Fall 2010)
2. HLTH 2500: Peer Health Education Training, SL* (Initially approved in Fall 2010)
3. COAD 6406: Counseling in Schools, SL (All sections) (Initially approved in Fall 2011)

Newly approved courses:

4. NURS 3340/3341: Nursing Care of Children, SL, All sections
5. THEA 3031: Youth Theatre II, SL, All sections
6. THEA 4141: Internship in Production and Performance in Theatre for Youth II, SL, All sections
7. THEA 3032: Constructing Performance Projects in Theatre for Youth, SL, All sections
