

- I have filled out and signed the Application for International Undergraduate Admissions.
- I have enclosed the application fee of \$60 payable to "East Carolina University"
- I have enclosed copies of all previous I-20s, a copy of your passport ID page, your I-94 and visa page.
- I have requested for all of my official transcripts, mark sheets, diplomas, and certificates to be sent to ECU. Please remember that documents which are not in English need to be officially translated. Students who have or will have an equivalent of Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree before enrolling at ECU do not need to submit secondary school transcripts.
- Non-native speakers of English.
I have arranged for TOEFL, IELTS, SAT or ACT report to be sent to ECU.
Applicants who have completed at least 24 credit hours at a U.S. institution of higher education and received a grade of B or better for an academic English writing course will be exempt from the English proficiency requirement.
- Form I-20 cannot be issued until you have been admitted to East Carolina University, have satisfactorily completed the [Confidential Financial Information Form](#) and have returned it to the Office of International Affairs with the evidence of financial resources.
- Once you are accepted to ECU, you should ask your previous international student advisor to fill out, sign, fax the [Advisor's Report](#) to (252) 328-4813 and mail it to us. Also have your advisor release your SEVIS record to us.
