

## **Medical Humanities Scholarship (Available for M1 and M2 students)**

The Dept of Medical Humanities invites first year students to submit a proposal for the Medical Humanities Summer Fellowship for the M1-M2 summer. The goal of the program is to stimulate interest in ethical, cultural, aesthetic, and social dimensions of health, disease, and healing. Two fellowships of \$2,000 each will be awarded on a competitive basis. Students may work on projects here in North Carolina, or they may use the fellowship as an opportunity to do a project abroad or elsewhere in the US. Fellows are expected to submit a 12—14 page paper (or other artifact, if appropriate, such as a video), and give a public presentation at the conclusion of the project.

To apply, students should submit a written 2-5 page proposal that includes a description of the project and its goals and methods, as well as a detailed budget by **Friday, February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2009** to Dr. Savitt (savittt@ecu.edu) in the Dept of Medical Humanities, Brody 2S-17. For help with writing a proposal, contact one of the faculty members whose areas of interest and expertise most closely suit the student's intended project.
