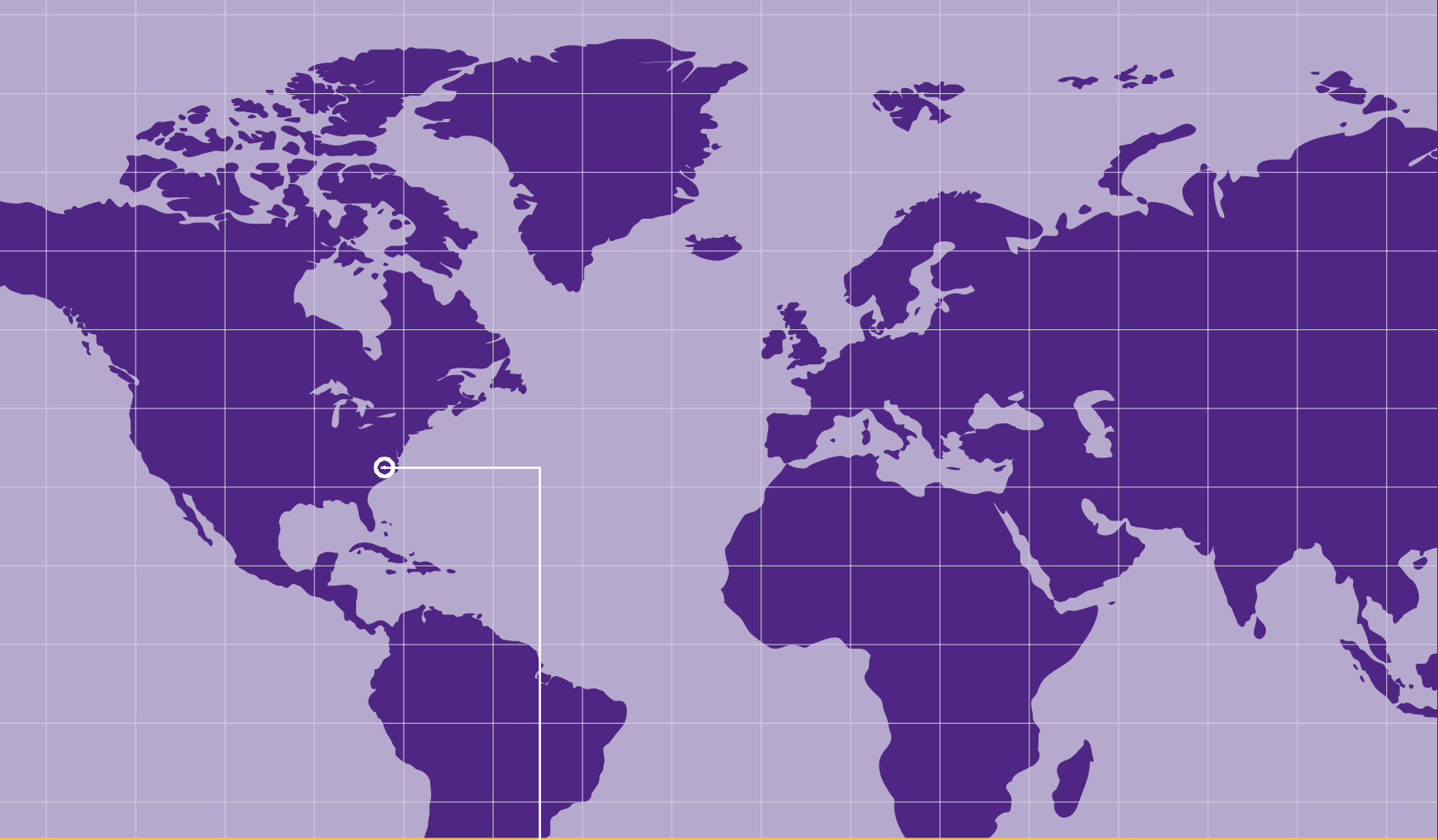

At East Carolina, you will find a nationally recognized research university with all the resources, programs, and opportunities that come with that title.

You will find top-quality housing, dining, and recreation. You can live in one of 15 residence halls and eat at two all-you-care-to-eat dining halls, five food courts, two convenience stores, four coffee bars, and a juice bar.

You will find a university that is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. In addition, individual disciplines at East Carolina—including business, education, and health care—are accredited by and have membership in more than 150 organizations.

You will find a diverse student population including international students from more than 50 countries.

You will find a vibrant campus alive with excitement and a student body with a devoted loyalty to its school. East Carolina is home to 17 intercollegiate athletic teams competing at the Division I-A level, intramural and club sports, a student newspaper, literary journals, a radio station, music and choral groups, drama and dance performances, concerts, lectures, a film series, internships, and more than 250 student organizations, including the International Student Association.

Admissions Process

The admissions process at East Carolina is easy. As an international student, you will need to submit three documents in order to be considered for admission—an application, your academic records, and proof of English language proficiency (if English is not your native language).

Application

The Application for International Undergraduate Admission should be filled out accurately and signed. A nonrefundable application fee must be returned with the application.

Academic Records

Official school records from all schools previously attended must be sent, including secondary study and postsecondary records. Non-English transcripts, mark sheets, diplomas, and certificates must be officially translated. Both the original records and the officially translated records must be submitted.

Proof of English Language Proficiency

Applicants whose native language is not English must demonstrate English proficiency by submitting official TOEFL, IELTS, SAT I Critical Reading, or ACT English scores.

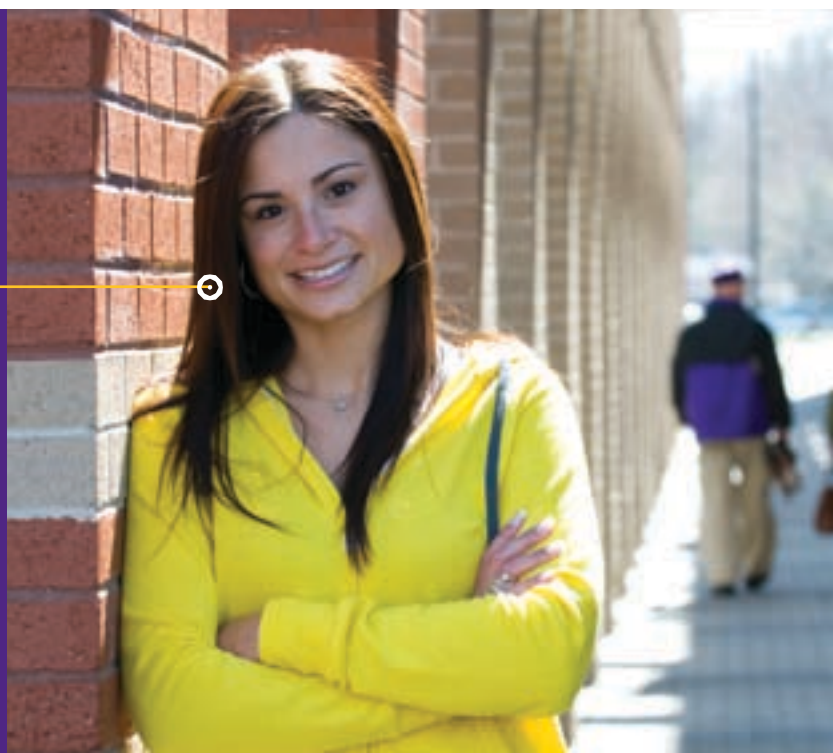
In order to have an I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant [F-1] Student Status) issued, international students are also required to submit the Confidential Financial Information Form together with documents showing they have sufficient financial resources to fund their education in the United States.
