



## **International Opportunity Ideas FUNDING: 2008-2009**

### **BSOM Rotaract Scholarship (Available to all participating members of BSOM Rotaract).**

Eligibility: Funds are available to medical students who are participating members of BSOM Rotaract and are interested in travelling abroad for purposes of exploring international medicine/research.

Requirements for qualifications for the scholarship:

1. Must complete 20 or more community service hours per semester. Hours must include volunteer work for 2 or more Sundays at Grimesland Free Clinic. Hours should be documented by applicant and sent to the Secretary of BSOM Rotaract.
2. Must participate fully in all of BSOM Rotaract's fundraisers.
3. Must be present at at least 75% of BSOM Rotaract meetings.
4. Must pay yearly dues.

Applications process: Applicant will provide a written, detailed description of program or research experience, place of experience, dates of travel, physician/principle investigator in charge, and applicants' roles and responsibilities at the site. Descriptions should be limited to one page or less. Applicants must also provide an estimation of costs, including airplane/transportation tickets, room and board, and program fees.
