The Department of Child Development and Family Relations offers the Preschool Add-On License to individuals who currently hold a clear license in Elementary Education, Special Education, or Family and Consumer Education/Child and Family Development.

Admission Requirements:

Send the following information to Dr. Melva Burke, Office of Alternative Licensure, School of Education, East Carolina University, Greenville, NC 27858-4353.

- A letter stating your desire to obtain the Preschool Add-On License
- A copy of all current licenses
- Official transcripts of all college work
- A recent resume

Special Requirements:

- CDFR curriculum and assessment courses require 20 hours of practicum. Professor will work with student to complete clinical component in student's area if possible.
- Face to face course orientation required.
- Face to face technology training required.

Required Courses:

The Preschool Add-On License qualifies individuals to be employed in Pre-Kindergarten classrooms in the public schools. Individuals must complete (with a grade C or better) the following courses in order to meet the competencies for the Preschool Add-On License.

- CDFR 4306 3 s.h. Directing Behavior and Development of Children
- CDFR 4322 3 s.h. Preschool Methods and Materials
- CDFR 4406 3 s.h. Parent-Professional Collaboration
- SPED 3510 3 s.h. Methods in Early Childhood Special Education
- SPED 3511 1 s.h. Practicum in Early Childhood Special Education
