
POST-MASTER'S CERTIFICATE

Nursing Education

Nurses with a master's degree in nursing are eligible to continue graduate study and obtain a post-master's certificate in Nursing Education. The post-MSN certificate options offer registered nurses advanced practice education, qualifying them to take national certification exams. Students complete course work in the Nursing Education in which a national certification exam is being planned for the near future. The Nursing Education concentration is offered online. Applicants for post-master's certificate option need to complete the Application for Admission to Graduate Degrees or Certificate Programs which can be completed online at www.ecu.edu/gradschool or obtained from the Graduate School. MAT or GRE scores are not required for this post-master's option.

The following four courses are required of all students in the certificate program.

NURS 6903 Curriculum Development in Nursing: Foundations, principles, and contemporary issues related to curriculum development in nursing education.

NURS 6904 Educational Concepts, Theories, and Strategies in Nursing: Explores learning theories and educational strategies used by nurse educators.

NURS 6909 Evaluation in Nursing Education: Focuses on evaluation of students, faculty, curricula, and programs in nursing education.

NURS 6905 Nursing Education Role Practicum I: Guided practicum with nurse educators in academic and health care settings.
