<p>White Paper</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> Copier paper, computer paper, bond paper, etc.</p>	<p>No NCR paper, wax/ coated paper, cups, food wraps, fax, or any other paper in this category. Staples and paper clips ok. No binder clips or A-clips.</p>
<p>Mixed Paper</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> Phone books, magazines and glossy paper, fax paper, colored paper, envelopes w/ plastic windows, etc.</p>	<p>No NCR paper, wax/ coated paper, cups, food wraps, newspaper, or any other paper in this category. No binder clips or A clips. No spiral-bound notebooks or 3-ring binders.</p>
<p>Newspaper</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> Newspaper only.</p>	<p>Newspaper Only.</p>
<p>Plastic, Glass & Cans</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> Aluminum cans, plastic bottles labeled #1 and #2, and glass beverage bottles</p>	<p>No non-beverage or heat treated, Pyrex, ceramic, or window glass. Please remove caps, and rinse before recycling.</p>
<p>Cardboard Boxes</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> Cardboard boxes and other cardboard materials.</p>	<p>No Styrofoam packaging materials, wax/coated or food- contaminated cardboard in this category. Housekeeping will place beside nearest dumpster for pick-up.</p>
<p>Scrap Metal and Wood</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> All scrap metal, wood, and wood pallets.</p>	<p>No Styrofoam, metal crate straps, or heavy duty plastic wrap in this category. No plywood, painted, or salt-treated wood.</p>
<p>Batteries</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> All batteries.</p>	<p>Faculty and staff may contact safety@ecu.edu for pick-up.</p>
<p>Ink/Toner cartridges</p>	<p><u>Includes:</u> All print or toner cartridges.</p>	<p>Faculty and staff may contact Central Stores at 328-9941 for pick-up.</p>
