If you are receiving financial aid, you must endorse your financial aid checks at the Brody Building Cashier's Office before they can be applied to your account.

East Carolina University is pleased to offer you a new service. Beginning **JANUARY 2006**, you will have a choice as to how you receive any financial refunds from the university.

You must choose one of the following options to use this new service:

1. The ECU Debit Card: This is a DEBIT CARD with a MasterCard logo issued by Higher One. Through this service, the ECU Debit Card will be accepted by over 24 million merchants worldwide. Cardholders can get cash from ATMs, write checks, send and receive money electronically from their accounts, and monitor the details of their account online. (Receive refund in 1 day or less.)
2. Direct Deposit: Your refund can be transferred to your current checking account. (Receive refund in 2-3 business days.)
3. Paper Check: You may continue to receive a paper check. (Receive refund in 5-7 business days.)

Directions will be forthcoming by mail in November about how to designate which refund option you select from the above list.

If all tuition and fees have not been paid by 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 22, 2005, a late payment fee will be assessed to your account.
