Code	Activity
AC	Arts & Culture - Efforts involving museums, performing arts, historical sites and programs; ethnic and cultural exploration and education programs; awareness and education for the arts.
CS	Community Service - Service to improve a neighborhood or community.
Ed	Education - Service in schools or community-based learning programs at all levels.
En	Environment - Planning or implementation efforts; education; public awareness; protection and/or enhancement.
He	Health - Service providing physical and/or mental health care; substance-abuse prevention and/or rehabilitation.
HN	Human Needs - Job training and placement; child care; youth and community recreation; services to the elderly, people with disabilities, families, and/or children; assistance to homeless or indigent persons/families; housing and short-term crisis resolution; or social services.
PS	Public Safety - Assistance to victims of crime; public awareness and prevention programs; criminal rehabilitation; crisis intervention.
SJ	Social Justice/Advocacy - Efforts to bring together diverse groups within the community to focus on creating and strengthening social ties; to address community issues, needs, and problems; and/or to promote equity and justice.
PL	Professional Leadership: Membership in professional organizations in different disciplines, while valued, is not applicable. However, a leadership role which goes beyond normal membership would be applicable. Examples are holding offices like Chair or Treasurer, or serving on editorial boards on the state, regional, or national level.

**Activities that may not be considered for induction include:**

- Any form of religious proselytizing (engaging in religious instruction, conducting worship services, etc.)
- Activities directly related to the nominee's job
- Acts of service that result in stipends, salary, or other forms of financial gain
- Service on a University Committee
