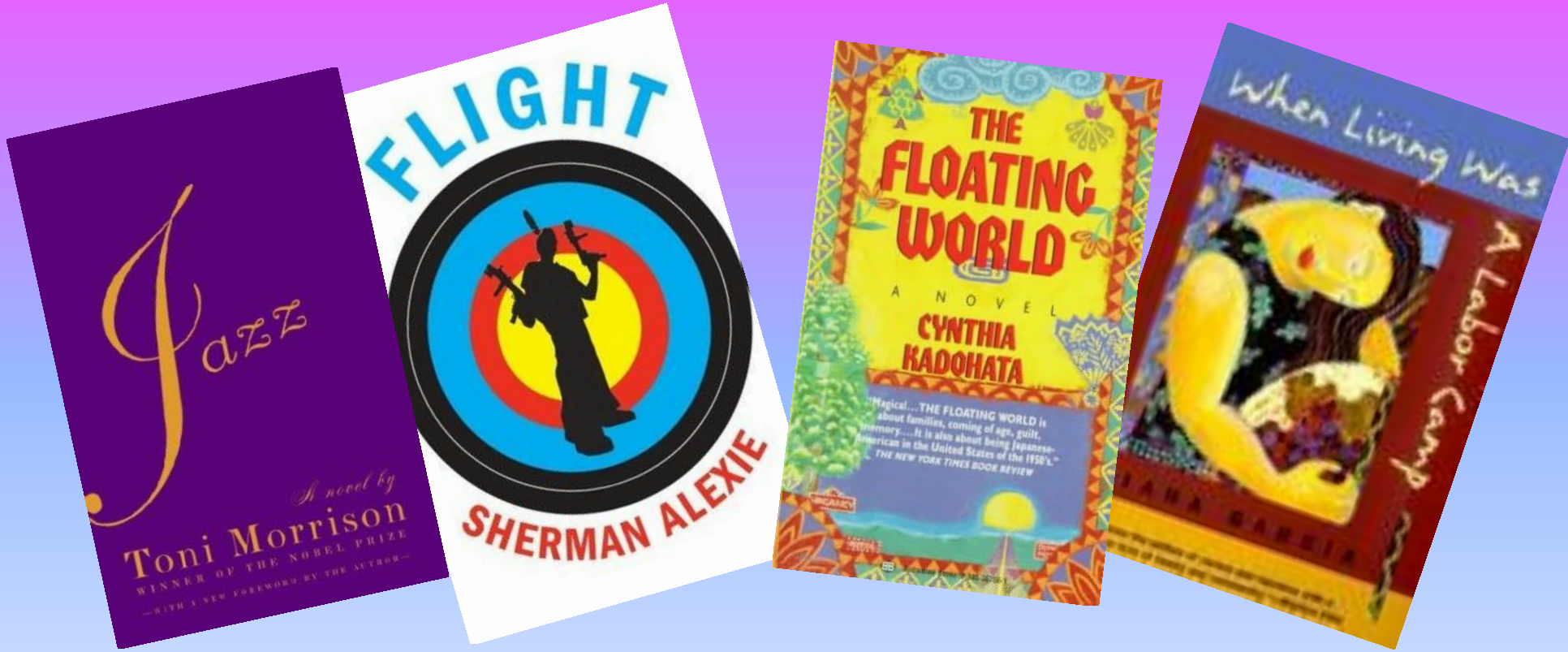


ENGL 4340 Ethnic American Literature (FC: HU) (Spring 2012)
