



Call for Poster Presentations 2nd Sustainability Symposium

Sustainability has emerged as a primary concern for many sectors, including academic institutions and industries around the world. This campus-wide sustainability event, supported by the Center for Sustainability within the College of Engineering and Technology, will present thought-provoking examples of sustainability ideas, analyses and practices. The event will promote approaches that adopt/implement inclusive views of the key dimensions of sustainability (environmental, economic and social) to address present and future needs. The goal of the event is to catalyze and stimulate discussion on how sustainability can be integrated into research and industry practices, especially those that will benefit eastern North Carolina.

ECU students are invited to submit posters to be presented in the symposium.

The poster should convey a broad sense of sustainability related research, projects, and programs including, but not limited to energy, agriculture, climate, transportation, built environment, travel, hospitality, food, waste reduction, pollution prevention, water, health and wellness. Awards will be presented to the top three posters.

Posters must include name, affiliation, and contact information (email) for the corresponding poster author. Information about all co-authors must also be provided.

To be considered for participation at the poster session, an abstract must be submitted by **September 21, 2018**. Abstract contents must include a proposed/completed holistic approach to sustainability that is implemented in a project, program, or analysis. Applicants should use 3'x4' dimensions for their posters.
