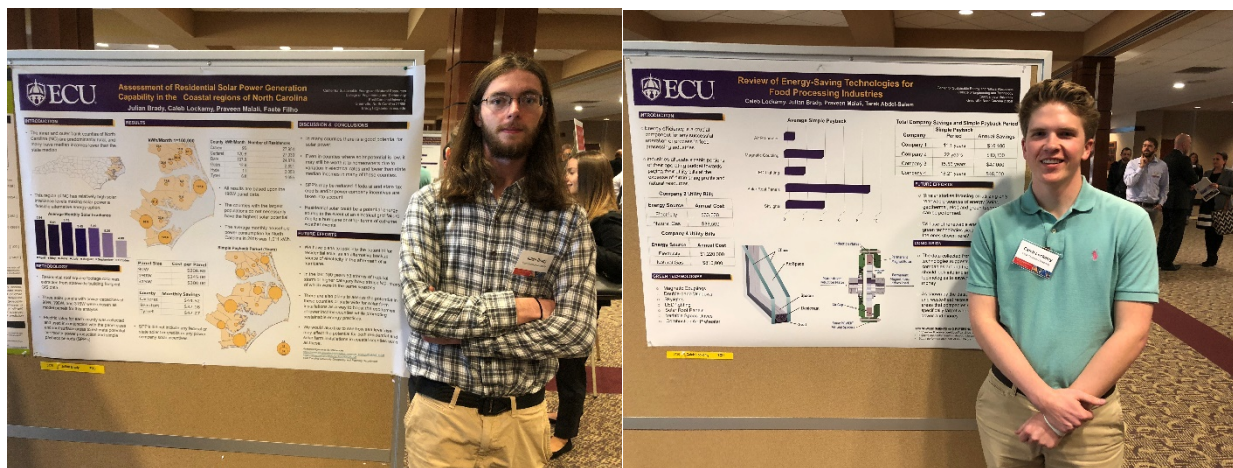


Student Poster Presentation at 2018 State Energy Conference of North Carolina April 17th, 2018
