@ Deadline: November 10, 2006

@ Composers of all ages and nationalities are invited to submit a maximum of two orchestral scores to the 2007 NewMusic@ECU Festival Orchestra Composition Competition.

@ Maximum instrumentation:

3 fl (double picc/alto), 3 ob (eng hn), 3 clar (bs, e-flat), 3 bsn (contra);
4 hn, 3 tpt, 3 tbn (including bass tbn), 1 tuba;
Strings; Harp; Timpani + 2 percussion; Piano

@ Works with electronics/computer WILL be considered

@ Difficulty level suitable for advanced university orchestra

@ Maximum duration: 12 minutes

@ Prize: Performance on March 4, 2007—the final concert of the 2007 NewMusic@ECU Festival by the East Carolina University Symphony Orchestra, Jorge Richter, Conductor, on the campus of East Carolina University, in Greenville, NC.

@ Entry fee per submission: \$15, payable via check or postal money order made out to “East Carolina University”, with the notation “NewMusic@ECU Festival” in the memo.

@ Postmark deadline: November 10, 2006.

@ Entries should include:

Two copies of each score; Cover page containing the composer's name, address, phone, and email contact info; Title of composition, list of instrumentation, date of completion, performance history; One paragraph bio; One paragraph program notes; \$15 entry fee per submission; Self-addressed envelope w/sufficient postage affixed for return of submitted materials; If available, a recording of the submitted work(s) may be included. Recordings are helpful but are not required.

@ The composer of the winning work must be available to attend the festival. Every attempt will be made by festival staff to provide accommodations. The composer of the winning work may also be asked to conduct a seminar, introducing their work to students and other festival attendees.

@ The composer of the selected work will be notified by December 15, 2006.

@ Parts for the winning work must be received no later than January 8, 2007.
