Dear Band Campers:

Welcome to Summer Band Camp 2010! The week of June 13-18 promises to be both fun and educational. Some final reminders as camp nears:

REGISTRATION INFO! This will take place at **CLEMENT DORM** (high rise) near downtown Chico's, and will last from 1:00 pm until 4:00 pm on 6-13. Please have the health certificate ready for our staff at this time if you have not mailed these already. Camp T-shirts may be purchased as well for 15.00. Pre concert orders for CDs will also be available at 16.00. After registration you may move your child into the dorm. Our counseling staff will be on their assigned halls for you to meet. After unloading, proceed to Fletcher Music Center at the bottom of College Hill Drive at 10th Street for locker assignment and audition. After completing the audition process the next scheduled activity is a meeting for campers and staff in the Fletcher Recital Hall at 7:30 pm. Parents, you may return home at any point in this process; with younger or first time campers, you may wish to stay until the 7:30 meeting.

Concert will take place at 7:00 pm, Friday, June 18 in Wright Auditorium. CDs of the concert will be available for order. We ask that everyone please stay for the entire concert so that campers are supporting each other.

Final check out will take place in an alternating schedule on Friday afternoon so your child will be ready to leave immediately after the concert. This procedure will take place according to band assignment. Due to new security procedures, a fee of **\$80.00** will be assessed for lost keys. Each lost key means a lock must be re-keyed. Please emphasize this important responsibility with your camper.

Discipline will be enforced just like any school-related function. Alcohol/drug use, smoking, breaking curfew, fraternization with non-camp members and disobeying instructions of camp staff will result in immediate removal from camp.
