This 10 hour activity-based workshop will focus on developing musical literacy and musicianship skills. Music educators will learn practical and positive ideas and techniques for cultivating music reading, audiation, dictation, elementary composition, musical memory,<sup>2</sup> and aural skills. Participants will explore how we 'learn' music, be given specific techniques for developing reading readiness and tonal and rhythmic literacy, and experience the TAKADIMI rhythm syllable system. Materials and teaching strategies will illustrate how the State and National Music Standards can be put into action in the music classroom. Music teachers at all levels and areas will find this workshop highly beneficial for their students and for their own teaching.
