AUDITION PROCEDURE Performance of three contrasting compositions (or movements of larger works) from the major repertoire for the instrument are required. Sight-reading and scales and arpeggios may be requested. For voice, one composition in the standard repertoire from each of the four languages (French, Italian, German, and English) is required. Applicants should perform literature that displays their abilities to the best advantage. Please be advised that a written examination in music theory and history will be administered at the time of audition.

Taped Auditions

Deadlines

To be considered for an assistantship, all applications must be received by March 1. To be considered for an out-of-state tuition waiver, all applications must be received by February 1. (Auditions can take place in March.) All other applications must be received by April 1.
