“The Globe Theatre”

National Objective: Goal 6: The learner will compare and integrate art forms by analyzing traditional theatre, dance, music, visual arts, and new art forms. Goal 8: The learner will understand context by analyzing the role of theatre, film, television, and electronic media in the past and present.
