

Lesson Plan

Title: “Guess Who!”

Type: Warm-Up Lesson

Ages: Grade Levels: 3-5

Time Length: 10-20 minutes

Materials: Index cards with specific characters on them

National Objective: Competency Goal 2: The learner will act by interacting in improvisations and assuming roles.

Specific Goals: To identify characters and cast roles from a variety of texts that include themes of citizenship and responsibility (2.01). The students will utilize improvisational skills to make character choices in the dramatic process (2.07).

Social Skills Goal: The students will develop and use listening skills in order to obtain a given objective. The students will also exhibit positive interaction with other students.

Procedures: The children will gather around on the floor. One at a time, they will come up and be given a card with a famous storybook character on it. They will then have to act out the character on the card, and the children still on the floor will have to guess who that child is portraying.
