

Federal Student Aid Programs

The federal government selected your application for review in a process called "Verification." Federal regulations require us to collect and compare this information before awarding federal aid. If there are differences between your application information and your financial documents, ECU may need to make corrections electronically.

Complete this **Verification Worksheet** and submit it to our office **within two weeks** so that your financial aid won't be delayed. We are unable to award you aid until verification is complete. What you should do:

1. **Complete, sign, and submit** this worksheet.
