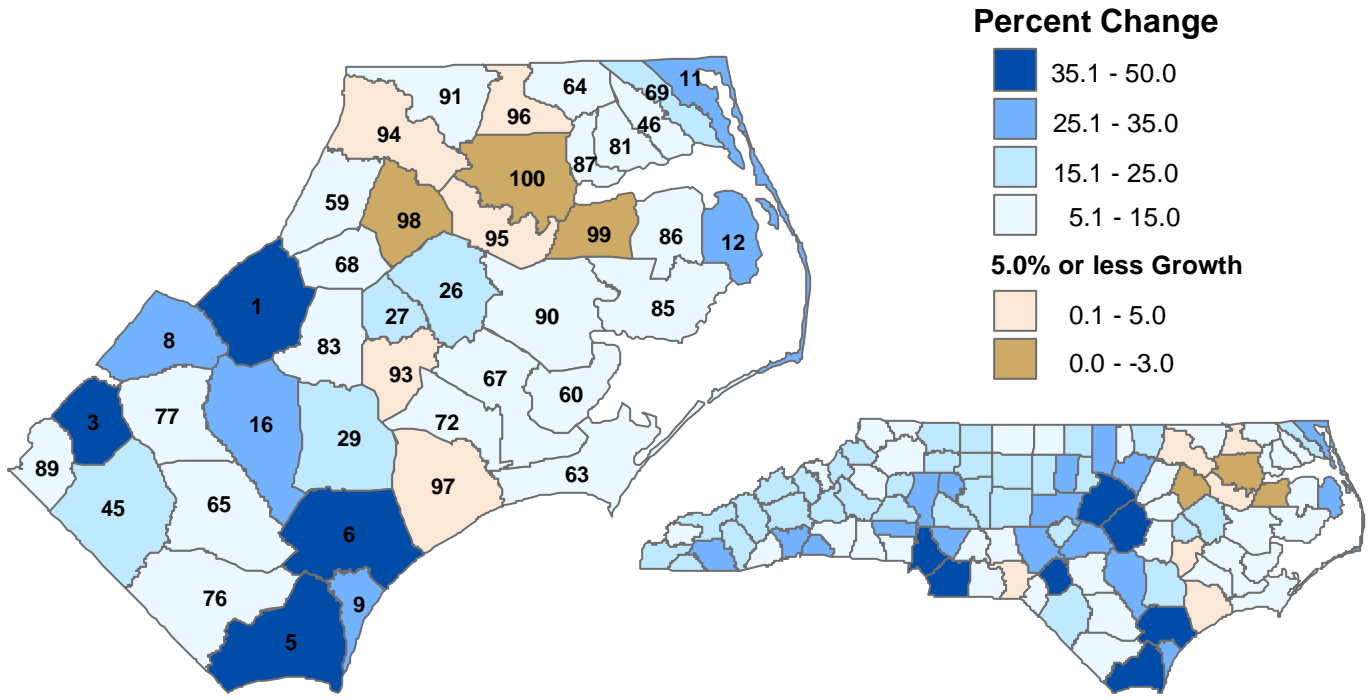
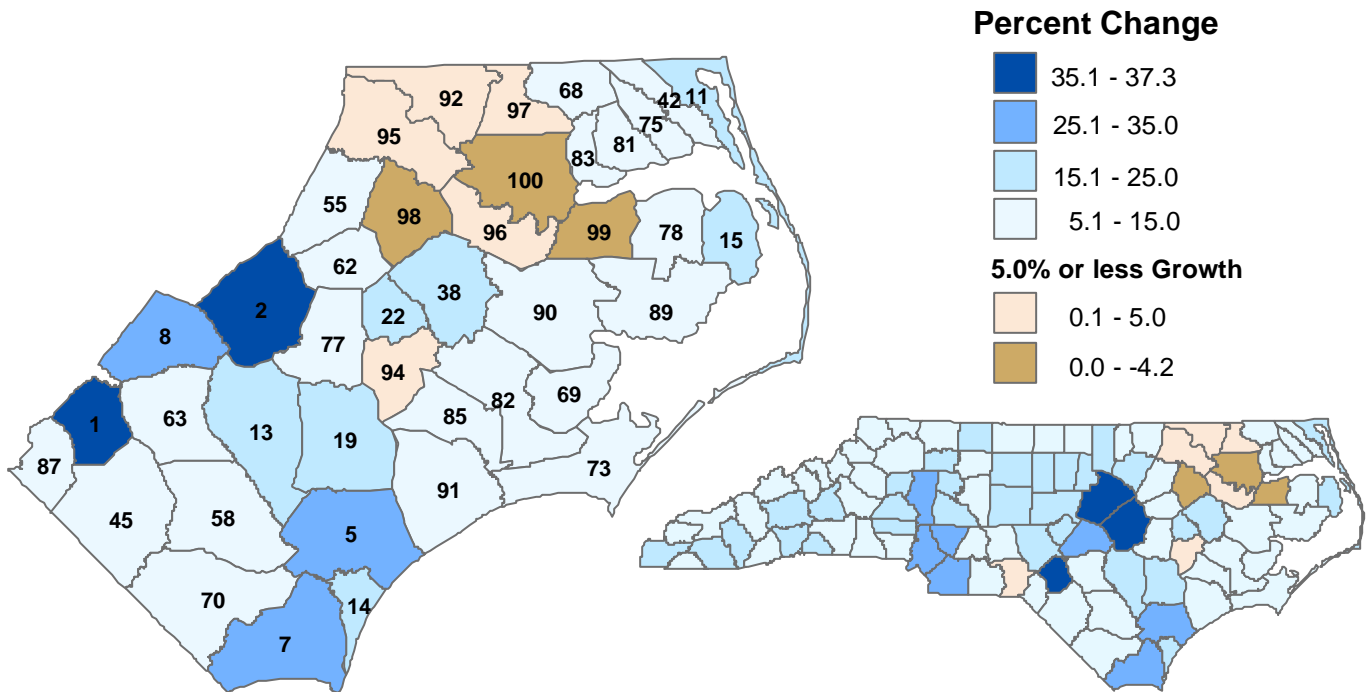


Percent Population Change with County Rankings* 1990 to 2000
