

1. Go to the Laupus Library webpage, <http://www.ecu.edu/laupuslibrary/>
2. Under the heading “Research” click on “Citation Linker” from the drop-down menu (just position the mouse pointer over the heading or click on the heading)
3. Fill in the search boxes with the information you have on the journal article you wish to find. If the article is from PubMed, you can type just the PMID in the appropriate box.
4. Click on the “Find it!” button located under the form.
5. If online full text is available, you should be taken directly to either the article or a list of volumes for the journal. You will need to look at your citation to select the correct year and volume and issue. (NOTE: If the page comes up and you do not see full text, or there is an error message, click the link at the top of the page that reads, “Click Here if You Don’t See Full Text.”)
6. If there is no online full text available or if you clicked on the “Click Here if You Don’t See Full Text” link, then you will be taken to a page with several links. (see picture below). Using these links you can search the catalogs of both Joyner and Laupus Libraries to see if a physical copy of the journal is available.

7. A new window will pop up with the library catalog. If the item is available in print within the library, you will see an entry for it. Check to see if the appropriate volume is available by looking at the information at the bottom of the page. Also, check which library holds the journal since the catalog contains information for several libraries.
