Foundation Curriculum Requirements 42		

A minimum of 40 semester hours or one-half of the total hours required in the major discipline must be completed at East Carolina University. Sixty-four or one-half of the minimum semester hours required in the student's program must be earned at a senior college.

The program is designed as a completion program for individuals with an associate degree or for those who have completed sufficient college transfer hours to be considered for entry into the degree track. Not all of the general education requirements for the degree are offered online by East Carolina University: Individuals who have not completed all of the general education courses before being admitted to ECU will need to take those classes at another institution or on campus at ECU as an on campus student. You will need permission from ECU to take classes from other institutions while enrolled at ECU.
