**ECU/PCS AIG Center 2007
Application**

Pitt County Schools (PCS) and East Carolina University's (ECU) College of Education Department of Curriculum and Instruction partner to provide the Academically & Intellectually Gifted Center (AIGC) each summer. ECU students receive hands-on teacher training under the leadership of master PCS teachers and ECU faculty. PCS students who are currently in grades 4 and 5 and identified as academically gifted receive an enrichment opportunity with enthusiastic teachers in small group settings. The AIGC randomly selects 40 students from applications received across all Pitt County elementary schools. Families are notified (accepted or not) by U.S. mail the week of April 16, 2007. If accepted, families receive a packet and are required to submit \$100 by May 1, 2007. If an accepted child chooses to not participate when contacted the week of April 16, 2007, please call Ms. Ruth Kilburn at 328-5338 so we may offer the space to another child. If an accepted child declines after June 19, the \$100 is non-refundable.
