

Certificate in Virtual Reality in Education and Training

The Certificate in Virtual Reality in Education and Training is designed for students who want to learn to use basic virtual reality software and to apply that knowledge in educational and training settings.

This certificate is current in transition and will soon be housed in the Department of Library Science. During this move the following information concerning the requirements of the certificate are subject to change. This changeover is expected to be completed in the fall semester of 2009.

The certificate requires 15 semester hours of credit as follows:

Courses required of all students: EDTC 6240, 6242, 6848.

Two elective courses, selected from the following, to complete hours for certificate:
EDTC 6244, 6991, 6992

Must be admitted to the Graduate School and meet the admission requirements as for the MS in Instructional Technology program.
