## **Program Description**

Wells Fargo Partnership East is making it possible for students throughout North Carolina to obtain four-year degrees in elementary education from East Carolina University in their local communities. Students graduate with a four-year degree from ECU by completing the first two years of the program at any North Carolina community college followed by taking ECU courses on-line and full-time in the area of elementary education.

- Do I have access to a computer with a high-speed internet connection?
- Am I knowledgeable of basic software applications– Microsoft Word, Excel , and Powerpoint?
- Am I comfortable communicating in writing and have good reading comprehension skills?
- Do I like to take responsibility and control of my own learning?
- Do I enjoy working in a collaborative environment with an instructor and other classmates?
- Do I have a willingness to share personal details about life, work and educational experiences?
- Do I possess excellent time management skills to commit time to studies on a weekly basis?
- Do I desire flexibility in the time, place, and structure of the learning environment?
- Am I self-motivated and disciplined and willing to work at least 5 out of 7 days per week?
- Am I interested in applying concepts and ideas of the class to my own life and work experiences?
- Do I possess good critical thinking and problem solving skills or have a desire to develop these skills?
- Do I believe that learning can take place anywhere at anytime?

## **What are the admission requirements?**

1. 3.0 GPA or higher
2. General Education coursework completed \*(see ECU Elementary articulation agreements on WPE website at [www.ecu.edu/wpe](http://www.ecu.edu/wpe))
3. Passing Praxis I scores or qualifying SAT/ACT scores. Test must be taken prior to application being accepted. Please allow 4-6 weeks to receive scores.
4. Completed advising appointment with WFPE coordinator to determine eligibility for program. Conference can be face to face, phone, or Skype.
5. Admission to East Carolina University. Students must meet ECU transfer admission requirements and be admitted to ECU to participate. Admissions requirements can be found at the ECU Admissions website at [www.ecu.edu/admissions](http://www.ecu.edu/admissions).
