Candidates complete the first two years of a four-year bachelor of science degree at one of the partnering community colleges and then complete the second half of the program by taking ECU courses through one of the consortia hub sites.

DEGREES OFFERED

- BS elementary education, grades K–6 with K–12 reading licensure
- BS special education, general curriculum with K–12 reading licensure
- BS middle grades education, grades 6–9

PARTNERSHIP FEATURES

Community College

- Completion of the general education course requirements at your local community college

- Community college counselors and advisors to guide you
- ECU coordinator located at the hub-site college to provide program information
- Teacher resource centers on the hub-site campuses

East Carolina University

- Completion of the second half of the program by taking ECU courses through one of the consortia hub sites
- 6 to 9 hours per semester and 3 to 6 hours each summer session, Summer I and II
- Virtual hub site that features totally online instruction
- Consortia hub sites feature totally online instruction face to face, online, and in blended delivery models including teleconferencing
- Less expensive than attending the on-campus program at ECU
- Small-college environment and personal advising
- Ample parking

ECU PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 2.5 GPA or greater
- Completion or near completion of community college course work

Note: Passing Praxis I scores give priority to applicants.
