



Educators Hall of Fame Scholarship

The Educators Hall of Fame recognizes and highlights the service of those educators and education advocates to whom East Carolina's alumni and friends are most grateful.

The legacy, begun by visionary leaders who established a teacher training school in 1907, has evolved into the nationally recognized East Carolina University College of Education. The spirit of the University's motto, To Serve, is reflected in the commitment and contributions of the students, faculty, graduates, and friends of the College of Education. It is to these lifelong facilitators of learning and advocates of social and personal values that we dedicate the Educators Hall of Fame.

The Educators Hall of Fame *Scholarship* was established in recognition of the University's centennial celebration beginning in March, 2007. The *Scholarship* will be awarded to deserving students from eastern North Carolina pursuing a degree in Education through the College of Education at East Carolina University and who wish to pursue a career as an educator in North Carolina. The \$2,500 (\$1,250 for each of two semesters) scholarship will be awarded to deserving students who meet the following criteria:

- Acceptance to attend East Carolina University
- Academic merit – at least a 3.5 high school true GPA (not weighted GPA)
- Demonstrated commitment to the study of and a career in education

Scholarship recipient(s) will agree to be ambassadors for The College of Education in such capacity as representing The College of Education at designated University and College of Education events and in assisting in future student recruitment efforts.

The scholarship award shall be for four academic years (eight semesters). At the discretion of the College of Education Selection Committee, the scholarship may be renewed as long as the recipient continues to meet the eligibility requirements.
