

MAT Portfolio—General Information

During your internship and over the summer you will be creating a portfolio that shows your competencies as a beginning teacher. You will begin this portfolio during the spring of this year (Part I) and will complete it during summer one (by the end of June).

The portfolio has two parts, Part 1 and Part 2. Part 1 will be checked by your university supervisor and in the case of HS English, by Dr. Al Muller (as the area coordinator). Your university supervisor will evaluate part one of your Portfolio. You will be responsible for securing and meeting deadlines set by your university supervisor. At the end of your internship, you will need to gather your portfolio to add the evidence for part two.
