PRAXIS I (Only)

This session is designed to focus on test-taking tips and strategies, resources, attitudes and dispositions needed to help teacher candidates master the **Praxis I Assessment**. The Praxis I exam is designed to be taken early in a student's college career and measures the student's proficiency in reading, writing, and mathematical skills. Participants in this session cover the three components of the Pre-Professional Skills Test--reading, math, and writing. Usage and sentence correction as well as essay writing are included in the writing component. The session includes resources and materials as well as highly interactive activities that will better prepare participants for test taking.

PRAXIS II (Only)

This session is designed to focus on providing the necessary test-taking tips and strategies, resources, attitudes and dispositions needed to pass the **Praxis II Assessment**. This session is highly interactive and provides participants a chance to dialogue and work with other participants. Study resources as well as specific test taking skills will be presented to participants. Included in the resources presented to participants are pedagogical skills and knowledge about the Principles of Learning and Teaching. Some generic resources will be provided to participants in various core content subjects, but individuals participating in the training have ultimate responsibility for securing the knowledge that they need to successfully complete the tests. Praxis II subject assessments measure candidates' knowledge of the subjects they will teach which include general and subject specific pedagogical skills and knowledge.
