

FOUNDATIONS CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS

Students must have at least 42 semester hours of foundations curriculum (FC) in order to graduate. Under the FC, there are six categories (listed below) that students must take a required amount of credit hours of coursework in that area to complete. All College of HHP majors have required courses listed under these six categories. Students must refer to the left hand side of their major's checksheet for this info!

Tips for utilizing this handout:

- Begin by filling in required FC courses for your major. Refer to your major's checksheet for this info. It will be listed on the left hand side.
- Next, review suggested courses and the exhaustive listing of FC courses to identify courses you would like to take where selection is up to you. Fill in these courses.

WI* - indicates courses that are typically writing intensive; for a course to be writing intensive, it must have the course attribute 'writing intensive' when looked up in Banner Self Service. NOTE students are able to search for classes by course attribute in Banner – please see HHP Advising Website (under Registration Info – How to Use Banner to Register) for more info on how to do this.

It is suggested that students utilize the online undergraduate university catalog (to check course pre-requisites) and WWW.RATEMYPROFESSORS.COM (to check professors) when selecting FC courses.

NOTE if a student does not place into MATH 1065, s/he will need to take remedial math.

* Math 0045 is remedial math for in-state students (2 hours)

* Math 0001 is remedial math for out-of-state students (2 hours)
