

Reapplying for Athletic Training Candidacy Period

Qualifications:

- Formal acceptance into the Athletic Training Candidacy Period (via an email signed by the Program Director)
- Previously enrolled in ATEP 1800 (Orientation to Athletic Training)
- Previously assigned clinical observation hours
- At the conclusion of the Spring semester, you must have a minimum of a 2.0 GPA, in both semester and cumulative areas
 - NOTE: If your semester or cumulative GPA falls below 2.0 over the summer session(s); you will not be admitted into the Candidacy Period.

If you meet the above criteria, and left the Candidacy period, or were not accepted into the Athletic Training major; you may reapply by following the rules below:

1. A letter, addressed to the Program Director, asking to be readmitted to the Candidacy Period. This letter must explain why you left, and detail how you are now prepared to meet the demands of the program. The letter must be dated, and contain your signature, address and email
2. Official transcripts from all colleges you have taken courses from since your original application. These must come in sealed envelopes
3. Signed and dated Technical Standards (found on this website)

Instructions:

- All of the application materials (above) must be sent together in **one** envelope

- Screening begins July 1
- Application Deadline is August 15; unless that date falls on a weekend; then it will be the Monday following August 15
- Acceptance will begin July 1 and continue until all Candidate slots are full; which may be sooner than August 15
