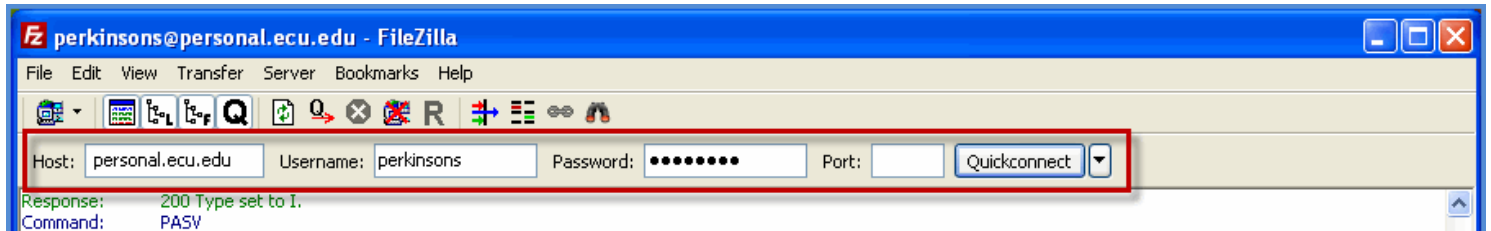


Web Upload to the Personal Server Using FileZilla

FileZilla is a free FTP (file transfer protocol) program. Download from the Internet and install the program. Open FileZilla and connect to your site by following these steps. **You can use this method both on and off campus.**

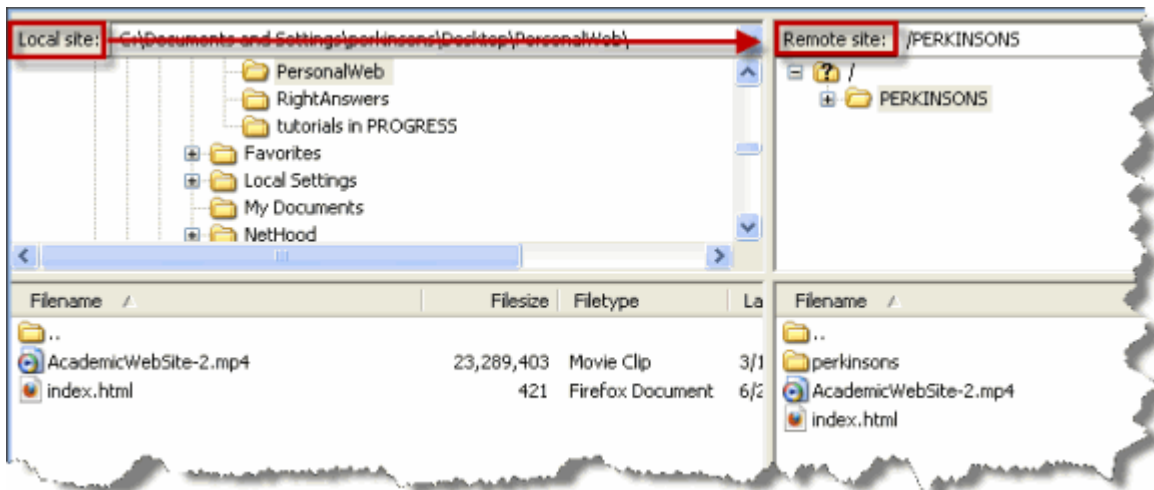
STEP 1. Connect to the Personal Server



Host = personal.ecu.edu **Username** = *YourPirateID* **Password** = Your current passphrase

Click the **Quickconnect** button. You'll see the interface below.

Step 2. Drag Files from the Local site (your computer) to Remote site (personal server)



Navigate to your Web folder in the **top left** box and click the folder.

Your Web page files will appear in the lower left box.

Drag the files from your Local site (your computer) to the Remote site (the Web server). Open a browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Safari) and check your site at <http://personal.ecu.edu/YourPirateID/>

STEP 3. Disconnect

When you have uploaded the files, disconnect from the personal server.

Go to Server >> Disconnect
