

Connecting to a Remote Site in Dreamweaver

1. Choose **Site > Manage Sites**
2. Select your local site and click the **Edit** button
3. Choose **Remote Info** from the category list on the left side of the dialog box
4. Choose **FTP** from the Access menu
5. Enter the following information:

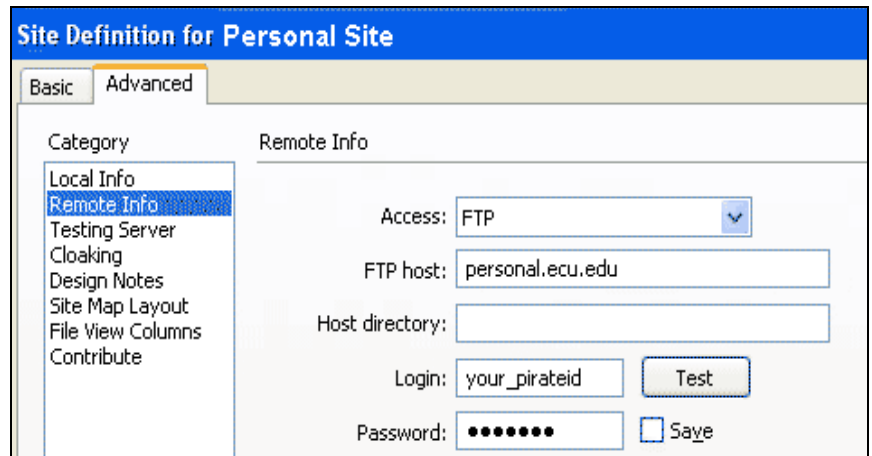
FTP host: personal.ecu.edu
(name of the web server)

Host directory: *leave blank*
(on personal you only have access to your own directory)

Login: Your pirateID

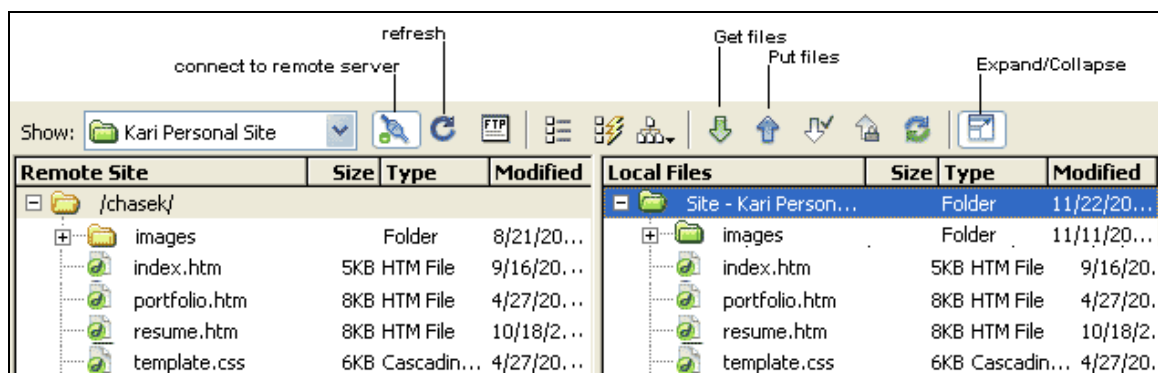
Password: Your password

Your website url will be:
http://personal.ecu.edu/pirateID



Uploading Files to the Server

1. Click on the expand icon on the **files panel** to view both the local and remote sites simultaneously
2. In the local files pane, select the top-level folder (your local root directory)
3. click the **Put** button (blue arrow)



4. When Dreamweaver asks if you want to put the entire site, click OK.
The entire local site is copied to the remote sever. To move individual files/folders, expand the local root folder, select the files/folders to move, click the put button.
