### THE FRIENDS OF JOYNER LIBRARY TO HOLD ANNUAL BOOK SALE

**Greenville, NC, October 13, 2005:** The Friends of Joyner Library at East Carolina University will hold their annual Book Sale, Friday October 28th and Saturday October 29th, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday October 30th from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. The Book Sale will be held in the Willis Building auditorium on the campus of East Carolina University, and located at 300 East First Street. Admission is free and the public is invited to attend. All proceeds from the sale will go towards supporting the Friends of Joyner Library.

The sale will offer an extensive selection of books from such genres as biographies and mysteries to text books and general interest books. Book prices typically range from fifty-cents to two dollars. Ample parking will be made available in the vicinity of the venue.

The Friends of Joyner Library at East Carolina University is a nonprofit organization that provides financial support to the library, which serves the university and the region. Gifts to the library are used to fund projects or purchases that may not be funded through the annual budget. Serving to elevate public awareness and raise funds for the library, their goal is to enrich both intellectual and educational environments for faculty, students, and citizens of eastern North Carolina.

J.Y. Joyner Library, and its branch Music Library in A.J. Fletcher Music Center, is the largest library east of Raleigh and offers state-of-the-art research services including significant collections of government documents, microforms, media resources, and North Carolina materials. It holds an impressive manuscript collection and the university archive, and is known for its extensive special collections and rare materials.
