- Individuals who are able to articulate both verbally and in writing their motivation for developing strong leadership skills
- Individuals who are in good behavioral standing with Campus Living, the Office of Students Rights and Responsibilities, as well as local, state, and national laws

Restored and renovated, Jarvis Hall offers a glimpse of East Carolina University's vibrant past and exciting future. First opened in 1909, the building has the distinction of being the first residence hall on campus. Additionally, Jarvis Hall once served as classroom space, with students lining the halls to hear faculty lectures.

Since Jarvis opened, it has been instrumental in creating community leaders and academic scholars. Currently, Jarvis brings both academic and out-of-class leadership experiences together to assist the development of civic minded and responsible citizens.

Participants experience personal, academic, and career-focused programs throughout the year while interacting with community members, civic leaders, and like-minded students. Also, the program engages participants through discussion of the leadership topics, developing plans of action, and forming life-changing relationships.
