Centralized Student Job Postings

We are pleased to report that a new process has been established so that students can find a job on campus via one central location. As of January 1, 2009, all Self-Help and Federal Work Study student job openings will be processed via the Student Employment Office to expedite this improved system.

The first step in this new process will be for departments to complete and submit the Job Posting Request Form online at, www.ecu.edu/cs-studentlife/hireapirate/campus_dept.cfm.

Once this step is completed, the Student Employment Office will send an email confirming the position has been posted and provide you with a job number.

This number must be included on either the Hiring Authorization Form (work study only) or Electronic Personnel Action Form (EPAF) in the comments section.
