ALUMNI SERVICES

The Career Center is the department on campus that facilitates career exploration, practical work experience, and professional development for students. We are dedicated to assisting ECU alumni meet career-related challenges after college. Our ongoing commitment to providing quality career services to individuals in the lifelong process of career development are exemplified through the following programs and resources offered through our office:

Pirate Alumni Network (PAN)

In cooperation with the ECU Alumni Association, the Pirate Alumni Network (PAN) is comprised of alumni who have graciously agreed to serve as a resource and offer their assistance to students who are transitioning from college to the workforce or to assist fellow alumni who are either relocating to a new area or are in the midst of a career change.

Job Search Advising/Coaching

Experienced staff members are available to discuss individual job search needs and assist alumni with developing and implementing job search plans.

Career Readiness Workshops/Special Programs

Career readiness workshops and special programs are continuously offered. Topics include: resume writing, job search correspondence, interviewing, job search strategies, and others.

Resume and Mock Interview Critique

Have your resume critiqued or practice interviewing techniques with a staff member. Mock interviews can also be provided upon request.

Career/Job Fairs
