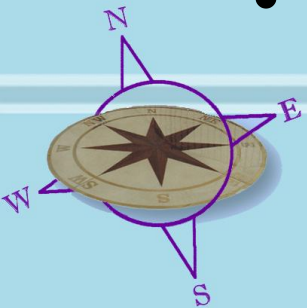
Identifying what you want to do after you graduate is an ideal way to select an academic major.

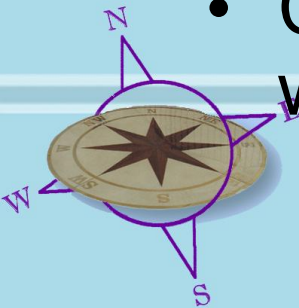
Discover Who You Are!

- Income/Lifestyle considerations.



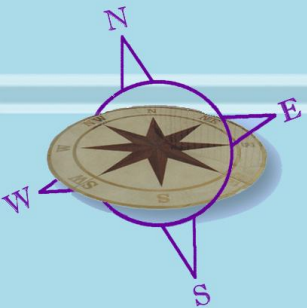
Discover the World of Work

- Create options: explore volunteer or paid work experience.

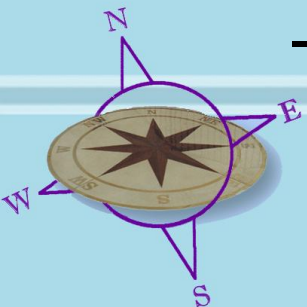


Identify and Evaluate Options

- Remember what you study may not be what you end up doing after you graduate!

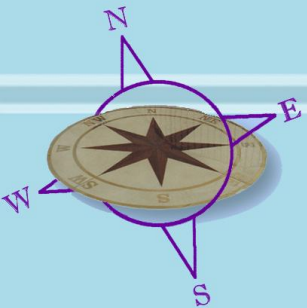


- Learn how to be an effective job seeker. Participate in workshops on:

 - How to Work A Job Fair.



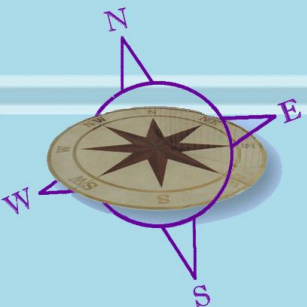

- Part-time, full-time work.



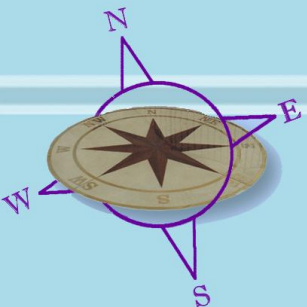
