Committee Purpose and Responsibilities:

It is the goal of the University to provide a healthy, safe and secure environment for all members of the campus community. The Campus Safety and Security Committee is an administrative advisory committee that promotes safety and security awareness across campus and advises on policy development and implementation. The committee shall review and evaluate effectiveness of current safety and security practices and make recommendations for improvement. The committee also provides a forum to discuss events affecting campus safety and security and assists with campus-wide communication relating to emergency planning. The committee also assists in assessment of vulnerabilities, hazards and risks related to the safety and security of individuals and the physical campus.
